### **Madison Magazine Announces Best Places to Work Winners**

**Madison, WI**— Madison Magazine’s October issue reveals the results of its annual Best Places to Work survey, featuring 35 companies across a variety of industry sectors and ranging in employment base from ten employees to more than 100.

The survey, conducted by Quantum Workplace of Omaha, Nebraska, measures six areas of employee engagement: communications and resources, individual needs, manager effectiveness, personal engagement, team dynamics and trust in leadership. Quantum Workplace found that the top-ranked Madison companies scored highest in the category of trust in leadership.

“In these changing times, it’s clear that this year’s top companies are exploring ways to meet the needs of not only their business, but also their employees,” says editor Karen Lincoln Michel. “The fact that trust in senior leadership is rated high seems to suggest that employees like the direction that their leaders are taking them.”
