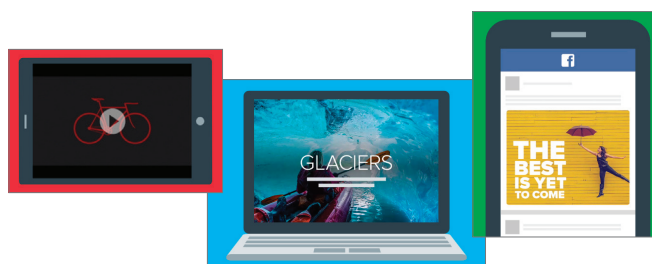

Designed for Chromebooks

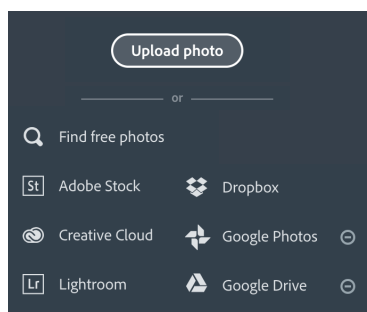

Use your existing Google username and password to log in to Adobe Express. The app connects to your existing Google Workspace for Education accounts, so your students can log in with the same credentials they already use.

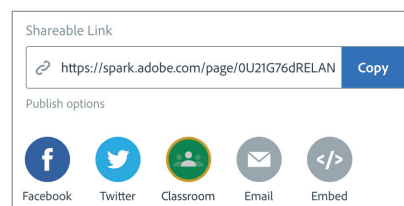
Quick access to Google Drive and Photos
