
Are you eligible?

"We're not sure Adobe Creative Cloud is essential."	"In a recent survey, nonprofits identified that the top 3 most important communication channels for them were all online — their website, email and social media. Now more than ever, how you communicate digitally will directly impact your ability to effectively spread your message, attract and retain donors, and connect with the community."	Tips Customers may purchase a Single App option to lower costs, but remind them that creative tasks are often interrelated and providing just a single app may stifle creativity. If they need 2-3 apps, the All Apps plan is more cost effective. Check the Creative Cloud for nonprofits licensing overview for a list of applications and services available for each type of license. Services are only available with named-user licensing.
"I'm concerned about the security of cloud-based services."	"All data stored by Adobe, on behalf of customers, has strong tenant isolation security and controls. You retain complete control and ownership of your data. And with device licenses, Creative Cloud is deployed anonymously, meaning no employee data is shared with Adobe."
